All applicants must sign and date the **Certification of Accuracy and Release of Information Waiver** on page 6 of application.

GENERAL GUIDELINES

- Each Scholarship Application must include a completed application form and high school transcripts, including SAT I, SAT II scores and/or Advanced Placement test scores (if applicant has taken any or all of these tests).
- Beginning with page 2 of the application form, all information should be typed or printed.

INFORMATIONAL GUIDELINES

To apply for one of **four (4) \$500.00 scholarships**, please address the following issues in the Scholarship Application:

One-page Resume / Page 2 of application

- Summarize educational history, honors and activities, and work experience (both paid and volunteer).

Educational Objectives / Page 3 of application

- Explain how the classes you have chosen during high school will enhance your ability to pursue your college, career and life goals.

Educational Financing / Page 4 of application

- Provide a brief account of the sources of your educational financing. What scholarships and grants do you anticipate from other sources?

Additional Information / Page 5 of application

If you wish, provide information to the Scholarship Committee about personal circumstances that have had a significant impact on your educational experience.

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SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

APPLICATION GUIDELINES

1. Applicants for WCSC and Won Buddhism of Philadelphia scholarships must attend Pennsylvania schools located in Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery and Philadelphia Counties. Students will be judged on the basis of three criteria: academic achievement (through grades, honors and awards), extracurricular school activities, and community involvement for the betterment of society.
2. To be eligible for consideration for a scholarship, the student must be expected to graduate with an overall high school GPA of B or higher in June 2010.
3. Applicants may include only one letter of reference as part of their scholarship application package, and a sealed letter of recommendation from their high school guidance counselor.
4. If the Scholarship Application is approved, the students must make themselves available to be interviewed at the Won Community Service Center on Saturday, April 10, 2010 between 2:00 PM and 7:00 PM.
5. Scholarship winners will be announced in mid-April. At that time, each scholarship awardee must be prepared to email one digital photo to WCSC to be used in a press release to local newspapers. Winners must also be prepared to attend an awards ceremony on Sunday, April 25, 2010 from 12:00 PM to 3:30 PM. Awardees will be photographed at the awards ceremony and the photographs will be used in press releases to local newspapers and will also be posted on the WCSC website.
